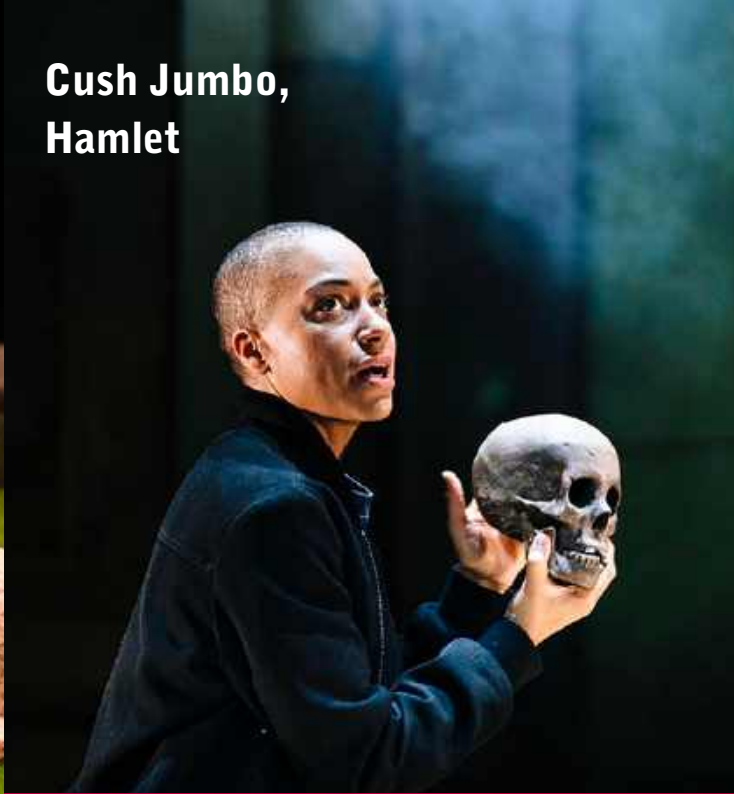

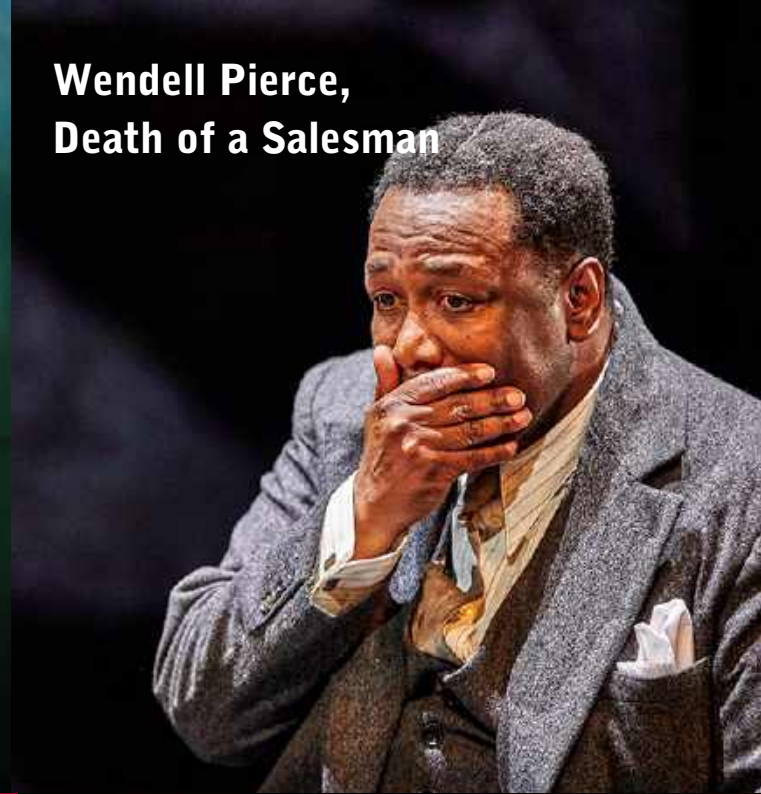

Taking Part

Young Vic

For over 25 years, Taking Part has provided free creative and artistic pathways into theatre, reaching over 15,000 participants from our local communities of Lambeth and Southwark annually. Taking Part includes:

Learning programme

Activities for local students to experience all aspects of theatre making: free tickets, in-school and onstage workshops, careers days, supported internships for neurodiverse students, and professional development events for teachers.

Participation programme

Bespoke projects outside of education for young people (14-25) including our 'Young Associates' programme employing local young people (18-25) to gain skills for a career in the arts; and creative workshops for young people in the criminal justice system.

Neighbourhood Theatre

Open to all local residents over the age of 25, includes a 160-strong company of local performers plus workshops, discussions, events and our playwriting programme, Neighbourhood Voices.

Creators Program

The Creators Program supports multi and anti disciplinary artists and producers and is the only scheme of its kind. It has developed some of the UK's most dynamic creatives who have gone on to make extraordinary work.

The programme offers creatives unique opportunities to develop their craft and careers including:

- A Future Directors Award providing a paid opportunity to direct a fully supported production at the Young Vic;
- A two-year Genesis Fellowship position working closely with the Artistic Director and participating in the theatre's programming and artistic planning;
- Opportunities to become an Associate Director, Assistant Director or Trainee Director on Young Vic shows.
